Room Parent Responsibilities

The main task as Room Parent is to work in tandem with your Room Parent co-chair and facilitate communication between the classroom teachers, the parents, and the Guild. You will help the classroom teacher with activities and event planning, which will vary depending on grade level.

Communication: Please reach out to the teachers as soon as class lists are distributed to discuss expected classroom responsibilities for the year. Ensure you're on the same page regarding a list of activities (such as mystery readers), celebrations (Halloween, Christmas), upcoming field trips, what additional supplies or resources they may need, STREAM Lab activities or any other ways in which the Room Parents might be of assistance to the teacher. Nursery / PreK parents will also assist classroom teachers in coordinating volunteers for various parties / celebrations (4 or 5) throughout the year. Please always plan to CC the Guild email when sending any communication to the parents. This simply helps us stay informed of classroom activities and events.

Events: We kindly ask that you sign up to chair a minimum of one Guild sponsored event (Ice Cream Social, Father / Daughter dance, Walk-A-Thon, Parent Social, North Pole Express, Family Movie Night, etc.) during the school year. More than one is welcome! In addition, you will coordinate teacher gifts twice per year: Christmas and End of year. We ask that you please stress that teacher gift contributions are not mandatory and any contribution is greatly appreciated. The Guild will coordinate and take the lead on Teacher Appreciation Week in May.

Misc: We encourage room parents to attend the four annual Guild meetings to stay informed of our updates and activities. As previously mentioned, all volunteers for the school both internal and external events, MUST have completed a CORI background check and attended the VIRTUS Protecting God's Children (one time class) before volunteering at any event. We ask that you help spread the word of our events and the necessary training required for parents and family to volunteer in the classrooms for celebrations, events, field trips and other actives hosted throughout the year.

Have Fun: Enjoy this time with your child(ren), their friends, teachers and the Guild! We are hopeful that this will be a rewarding experience for you, your co-parent and your child(ren).

Confidentiality: You will have access to sensitive information that is not to be shared, most notably parents' email addresses and contact information. The Guild will release classroom lists with all parent and student contact information. Please be advised that this is sensitive info and when contacting the parents via email, we ask that you use the Blind Carbon Copy (BCC) field. The school directory is available to all enrolled families with contact information of those choosing to be included.

Form Letters: Form Letters are available to help you communicate with your class throughout the year. The Guild is here to assist you with communications, and we will be in touch throughout the year to help guide you through when and what needs to be shared with your classroom teachers and parents.

Stay Informed: This helps you communicate all pertinent information to every parent such as events and fundraisers, especially since dates and times may change.
